Look out for callers that create a sense of urgency, offer unbelievable deals, or solicit personal information. Legitimate solar energy companies won't ask for private information like dates of birth, Social Security numbers, or financial details. What should I do if I receive a suspicious call about solar energy?

All the solar companies are scams, or will eventually be exposed "later" as a scam, or the recent solar company (DC Solar, Benicia, CA), a couple from Martinez was running a ponzi scheme from 2011-18 with over a billion dollars, and even scammed Warren Buffett from losing over \$350 million.

Know that "free" or "no cost" solar panel offers are scams. The federal government does not install solar systems in homes for free.
