

Anti theft system lost power

I'm guessing you may have the same issue. Honda always had an anti-theft code to unlock the car or reenable after losing power and I'm guessing the push button is similar to the radio aspect. So I would have Honda check your power connections for the battery. This is also likely why you could not use remote or power tailgate / doors.

After all of this I'll get the message saying the anti-theft system lost power and I'll have to hold the power button to restart it. Usually this will be accompanied by the "initializing systems" message.

The last two times I've driven my car I get an error on the touchscreen: Anti Theft System. This system has lost power. Push and hold the power button for more than two seconds to enable the system.

Understanding how anti-theft works. The vehicle anti-theft system or a device is installed on your car to prevent its theft or contents inside. The anti-theft system comes with sensors installed in and out of the vehicle. The sensors trigger the alarm system whenever there is an impact, movement, or disturbance in or outside the car.
