The average Duke Energy Florida customer uses about 1,450 kWh of electricity per month and has a bill of around \$240. Of that \$240, about \$12 is the monthly customer charge, while the rest is the cost of energy. Using solar energy, a Duke Energy customer can eliminate energy charges down to a minimum bill of \$30 per month.

Under that policy, solar homeowners used Duke Energy's Residential Service rate plan which charges about \$0.11 per kilowatt-hour (kWh) of electricity used from the grid. This also means any excess solar energy sent to the grid is worth \$0.11 per kWh.
