



Duke energy solar rebate program

The program sets aside 26 megawatts (MW) for low-income customers who participate in government subsidy programs or Duke Energy's low-income energy efficiency program, Neighborhood Energy Saver. With program enrollment, low-income customers will see guaranteed savings on their program costs every month.

With up to \$9,000 in rebates per system, Duke Energy PowerPair program reduces the cost burden of installing solar and battery systems in North Carolina. The incentive only applies to new solar AND battery systems. Solar-only and battery-only systems do not qualify. At this time, Duke Energy has not released any equipment eligibility requirements. There are two options in the program: PowerPair and PowerPair + EnergyWise Battery Control. The key differences are:
