Max participation caps for PowerPair are mandated by the North Carolina Utilities Commission and are limited to no greater than 30,000 kW-AC for Solar Panels in both Duke Energy Carolinas and Duke Energy Progress. Participation will be subject to availability of the Net Metering Bridge Rider NMB and the Residential Solar Choice Rider RSC.

The South Carolina Public Service Commission issued two orders in May 2021 adopting new Solar Choice Tariffs for Duke Energy Progress, Duke Energy Carolinas, and Dominion Energy South Carolina. Customers who installed their systems on or after January 1, 2022 must take service under the Solar Choice Tariffs described below.

Duke Energy Carolinas serves about 591,000 customers in the Upstate region of South Carolina, including Greenwood, Greenville, Spartanburg, Lancaster and York counties.
