## Engine on due to system power needs



Common reasons: power-consuming units are working, battery is low. How to fix: check the battery. Possible consequences: start-stop may not work. Priority level: Low. Can you drive? Yes. DIY repair: Possible. Repair price range: \$0-\$200. What Does " Engine on Due to System/Power Needs" Mean?

So long as the parameters are met (engine not flat out cold etc) then the normal message is "start/stop system is available" (or similar phrase) but for the duration of the regen it is "engine must be running".

The system automatically determines if it can shut off the engine or if it needs power to keep stuff on. You don"t want to drain your battery and the manufacturer isn"t going to toe a risky line. If you"re drawing a certain amount of amps, it"ll simply stay on so your alternator is producing power and not drawing from your battery.

A "Reduced Engine Power" or "Engine Power Reduced" warning means your engine isn"t working at full capacity. This alert is triggered when your car"s computer detects an issue in the throttle, fuel, emissions, or other critical components.

Second: I'm getting a message that says Maneuver Braking Function Not Available right when I turn on the car and in the vehicle status there's a message Engine on due to system/power needs. I've never seen anything like this before; in fact the thing has been flawless up until this point.

Reduced engine power is more than just an inconvenience - it's a warning sign that your vehicle needs attention. By understanding what causes engine slowdowns, you can address the issue. Doing so will ensure your vehicle stays in top shape.
