Prior to publication of the IFR, only lithium metal cells and batteries were prohibited from transportation as cargo on passenger aircraft. For smaller lithium metal cells and batteries, the HMR required that these packages display a statement of prohibition or the cargo aircraft only (CAO) label, regardless of the mode of transportation.

Ground shipments need "Lithium Batteries-Forbidden for Transport Aboard Aircraft and Vessel" text marking. Overpack Markings: When batteries are shipped in an overpack, the essential markings and labels must be evident or reproduced. The overpack of lithium-ion batteries must be marked with the "OVERPACK" word.

This rule codifies the following: Prohibits the transport of lithium ion cells and batteries when packed alone as

cargo on passenger aircraft. Requires lithium ion cells and batteries to be shipped at not more than a 30% state of charge aboard cargo-only aircraft if not packed with or in the equipment it is meant to power (i.e., packed alone).

These "Lithium Metal Batteries Inside" markings meet new requirements for shipping non-rechargeable lithium metal batteries, and may be used to help meet the revised DOT marking requirements including the appropriate telephone number for additional information.

(6) Lithium cells and batteries. Lithium metal cells and batteries (UN3090) and lithium ion cells and batteries (UN3480) are forbidden for transport as cargo aboard passenger-carrying aircraft.

(4) Each package must be marked "LITHIUM BATTERIES--FORBIDDEN FOR TRANSPORT ABOARD AIRCRAFT" on a background of contrasting color. The marking must be durable, legible and of such a size relative to the package as to be readily visible and include any special procedures that should be followed if the package is damaged;

Finally, when smaller lithium cells and batteries (both ion and metal) are offered as cargo on cargo-only aircraft, they are limited to one package per consignment as provided in § 173.185 (c) (4) (iii).
