While Steinberg (2007) identified the need for proper housing location in users satisfaction research, Oliver-Smith (1991) put greater emphasis on psychological needs and the quality of interior spaces which implicitly refers to the importance of the environmental dimension of housing construction for post-disaster resettlement.

In addition to this, the resettlement housing is sometimes perceived as a completed product where the actual needs, norms, culture, and way of life of the relocates are not taken into account.



In addition, resettlement by location may involve either completed housing or incremental housing strategies or both. A recent initiative under the RP is the five-year (2011-2016) 50 billion Oplan Likas (Lumikas para Iwas Kalamidad At Sakit) housing program for the relocation of around 104,000 ISFs residing along danger areas in Metro Manila.
