

Solar company bankrupt

In the U.S., filing for Chapter 11 bankruptcy sets off a reorganization process that allows the company to keep its business alive and pay its creditors over time. Historically with the solar industry, the buyer in many cases has taken over responsibilities such as upholding warranties.

More bankruptcies may be on the horizon, too - in California alone, a whopping 75% of solar companies are now under financial duress, according to research from solar warranty provider Solar Insure For consumers with solar panels, a solar provider's bankruptcy is more than just a headline; it can be the start of a huge headache.

The company filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy, which allows a company to restructure while it continues to operate. Complete Solar, acting as a "stalking horse buyer," was awarded the bid for a portion of SunPower's assets, including Blue Raven Solar, SunPower's New Homes business, and a portion of SunPower's Dealer network.

SunStore Solar and Let's Go Solar filed for voluntary Chapter 7 bankruptcy -- a move that may result in the end of the companies' operations -- and UniEnergy Technologies was forced into proceedings through an involuntary Chapter 11 bankruptcy petition filed by a number of its creditors.

SunPower is the largest solar company to fall in the past year, but it is far from the only casualty. Dozens of companies have gone bankrupt or left California since the start of the "net billing tariff", also known as "NEM 3", in April 2023.

Sunworks, a residential and commercial solar developer headquartered in Provo, Utah, and three of its subsidiaries filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy on Monday, according to a document the company submitted to the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). Under Chapter 7 bankruptcy, and as stated in the filing, Sunworks' assets "will be ...

Dozens of other solar firms have failed this year as well, including Infinity Energy, Solcius, and Kayo Energy. "We pretty much have a \$70,000 roof ornament at this point," says Jasmine Hendrickson, who had a system installed by Pink Energy a week before the company went out of business.

SunPower, a leading residential solar installer, has encountered a "severe liquidity crisis" and must sell its assets to pay down more than \$2 billion in debts, company officials said.

Is Freedom Solar going bankrupt / entering Chapter 11? No. Freedom Solar is one of the strongest players in the solar sales, installation, and service industry. The company has no reason or intention to consider a bankruptcy filing. Freedom Solar is a privately held, founder-led, locally owned company since 2007.

Bankruptcy or legal action (which might result from any of the factors mentioned above) can also lead to the demise of a solar company. Experts say it's important to choose a good solar installer ...
