The Solar Power Tour was the third concert tour by New Zealand singer-songwriter Lorde, in support of her third studio album *Solar Power* (2021). The tour took place from April 2022 to March 2023, spanning over 70 shows in North America, Europe, Latin America and Oceania. The show consisted of three segments and an encore, with two or three costume changes.

Lorde told Apple Music's Zane Lowe on Primal Scream's 1990 dance rock single "Loaded" inspired her song, though she hadn't come across it before penning "Solar Power." "I had never heard Primal Scream in my life. I'd been told to check them out," Lorde said, adding that when she wrote the tune on the piano, she realized it sounded similar to the English band's track.
