



Usps lithium battery regulations

USPS has strict rules for shipping batteries, and one of the most critical factors is Watt hours (Wh). If you do not know how to calculate Watt-hours, here is the formula: Amps X Volts = Watt Hours. Lithium batteries that power ...

If you use the United States Postal Service to ship products that contain hazardous materials, including lithium batteries, the newest changes to USPS Publication 52 (Pub 52) will affect your shipments. The changes were published as an interim final rule on June 6, 2022, and are effective immediately for any hazmat shipment.. Two main changes were made to Pub 52:

There are currently six types of lithium batteries eligible for shipment, in varying domestic or international quantities, via USPS: Lithium-ion (rechargeable) battery, UN3480. ...

For international mail, the lithium batteries MUST be installed in the equipment. ? Not to exceed 4 cells or 2 batteries per package. ? Lithium batteries alone, or lithium batteries packed with (but not installed in) equipment, are not acceptable for international mailing.

1. Is the lithium battery rechargeable? a. If the answer is yes, it is a lithium-ion (polymer) battery and you must: (1) Refer to UN3480 for lithium-ion batteries packaged without equipment. (2) Refer to UN3481 for lithium-ion batteries packaged with or in equipment. b. If the answer is no, it is a lithium metal (alloy) battery and you must:

DMM Revision: Mailings of Lithium Batteries . Effective May 16, 2012, the Postal Service(TM) will revise Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM ®) section 601.10.20 to codify that primary lithium metal or lithium alloy (nonrechargeable) cells and batteries or secondary lithium-ion cells and bat­teries (rechargeable) are prohibited when ...

The Postal Service announced these revisions via a Federal Register notice titled "Revision to Mailing Standards for Lithium Batteries," which was published on July 26, 2017 (82 FR 34712-34715).

The US Postal Service has revised the regulations for mailing hazardous materials, including some electronic devices containing or packed with lithium batteries. Effective immediately, the USPS Publication 52 standards for Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail are revised as follows: Shippers/mailers must separate hazardous materials requiring marks or ...

Lithium cells and batteries power countless items that support everyday life from portable computers, cordless tools, mobile telephones, watches, to wheelchairs and motor vehicles. ... (EPA) regulations apply to end-of-life lithium ion batteries under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). ... you must comply with all USPS (for USPS ...

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries installed in equipment (including circuit boards), or no more than 4 lithium metal cells or 2 lithium metal batteries installed in the equipment they operate, mailpieces containing lithium metal batteries must bear a DOT-approved lithium battery mark, as specified in 49 CFR 173.185(c)(3)(i) ...

The regulations for shipping batteries via USPS include the following: batteries must be properly packaged, marked, and labeled; certain batteries are prohibited from mailing; lithium batteries must not exceed certain watt-hour ratings; and additional documentation may be required for international shipments.

The Postal Service and its partner air carriers have identified pre-owned, damaged, and defective electronic devices containing lithium batteries as a particular and growing cause of lithium-battery incidents. Indeed, damaged, defective, and recalled lithium cells and batteries are already ineligible for air transportation. 49 CFR 173.185(f).

Lithium batteries, for example, are subject to specific packaging, labeling, and quantity limits to ensure safety during transportation.

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate, mailpieces containing mailable lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries must be rigid, sealed, and of adequate size, so the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address side without the mark being folded.

For shipping lithium batteries with USPS overseas, you can ship a maximum of 4 cells or 2 batteries that are installed in the new or certified refurbished equipment or device it operates, without any lithium battery markings. However, individual batteries are prohibited from USPS international shipping.
