

During the recycling process for lead-acid batteries, they are crushed. When lithium batteries are crushed in the same container, they explode. Lithium batteries need to be recycled and cannot go into the trash. It is also important to point out that placing Lithium batteries into regular recycling can cause fires at recycling facilities ...

When it's time to get rid of the batteries, start by checking local ordinances. A few cities and towns will recycle any batteries for you if you just leave them in a plastic bag on top of your trashcan. About half of states have laws mandating specific disposal methods for consumers.

You must take batteries to an authorized recycling center, a universal waste handler or a household hazardous waste disposal facility. When you know how to dispose of batteries, you can help the environment. Dropoff sites typically accept rechargeable batteries for recycling. For single-use batteries, you can get a mail-order recycling kit.

How to Recycle Right. The first rule in managing batteries safely is to always follow the manufacturer's instructions. Here are additional tips on preparing batteries for recycling. Collect and sort your batteries by type (e.g., lithium-ion, alkaline). Put on latex gloves to avoid any possible contact with powder or acid that can burn your skin.

If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling information. EPA recommendation: Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Find a recycling location near you: Ni-Cd; Li-ion; Ni-MH; Ni-Zn; Pb; Lithium-Ion ...
